THE U.S. AND ASIA: A STATISTICAL HANDBOOK 1988 EDITION

INTRODUCTION

Economic and political changes in 1987 once again draw the world's attention to the dynamism of the Asia/Pacific region. U.S. trade patterns continue the trend of recent years — in 1987 U.S. trade with Europe amounted to \$169.6 billion, while that with Asia topped \$240.8 billion. Meanwhile, significant political developments show that the rapid economic growth of many Asian countries is complemented by evolving democratization.

South Korea had the first peaceful transfer of presidential power in its history, following a four-man presidential election in December. The Republic of China on Taiwan continued the democratization efforts begun by its late President Chiang Ching-kuo. The People's Republic of China slowly expanded its own cautious economic and political reforms. Even communist Vietnam began to experiment modestly with greater economic freedoms and decentralization of government power last year.

To enable policy makers and the public to better understand the prevailing conditions in the countries of this vital area, The Heritage Foundation has compiled relevant statistics on 34 countries and territories in Asia. This third annual handbook published by the Foundation's Asian Studies Center updates Asian Studies *Backgrounder* No. 63, "The U.S. and Asia: A Statistical Handbook, 1987 Edition." This year New Caledonia has been added as events thrust it into the evolving political dynamic of the South Pacific. Three categories have been added: Infant Mortality, a useful measure of the living standard; Foreign Military Personnel, the number of foreign troops stationed in or occupying the country; and Armed Opposition Groups, indicating the level of domestic unrest.

The sources used in compiling this year's handbook are essentially unchanged from last year, and include: the Far Eastern Economic Yearbook, the International Institute of Strategic Studies' The Military Balance, the International Monetary Fund's International Financial Statistics Yearbook and Direction of Trade Statistics Yearbook, and the Central Intelligence Agency's World Factbook and Handbook of Economic Statistics. In addition, newspaper and magazine articles, foreign research organizations and foreign government reports filled the gaps in information. The U.S. Department of Commerce, the International Trade Administration, and the State Department's Office of Economic Policy were very helpful in providing needed information.

Economic statistics are based, as much as possible, on year-end 1987; population estimates are for July 1987, and political information is as current as possible.
