## Double vote in election earns woman probation

Franklin County Common Pleas Judge Stephen L. McIntosh placed her on probation for one year. The judge said he would send her to jail for 180 days if she violates probation.

Investigators said she submitted two absentee ballots -- one under the name Marian Wilson and the other as Marian Toles.

Elections officials working to clean up voter-registration rolls uncovered the irregularities last year.
