THE UNITED STATES ATTORNEY CHARGES:

COUNT I

That on or about May 1, 2002, the exact date being to the United States Attorney unknown, in the Eastern District of Arkansas, the defendant


LARRY GRAY

aided and abetted by persons known and unknown to the United States Attorney, did vote more than once in the May 21, 2002 Preferential Primary Election, held in Phillips County, Arkansas for the purpose of electing and selecting candidates, for among other positions both state and local, the offices of United States Senator and member of the United States House of Representatives, that is, the defendant **LARRY GRAY**, did fill out and submit more than 25 absentee ballots not his own and without the knowledge and consent of the registered voters whose ballots he voted and submitted, all in

violation of Section 1973i(e) of Title 42 and Section 2 of Title
18, United States Code.
