Mitchell man arrested on charge of voter fraud

MITCHELL | Police in Mitchell say they arrested a 54-year-old resident suspected of voting twice in Tuesday's school board election.

The Daily Republic reports that Craig Guymon was arrested on charges of voter fraud. Police say Guymon voted Tuesday morning at the Mitchell Career and Technical Education Academy and later returned an absentee ballot to the Davison Auditor's Office.

A telephone message for Guymon was not immediately returned.

Guymon has long been known in Mitchell as a vocal critic of school officials and had previously run for the school board on multiple occasions.

Guymon was booked at the jail Wednesday morning and released on a personal recognizance bond. The charge is a felony carrying a maximum penalty of two years in prison and a \$4,000 fine.
