JUDGMENT ENTRY ON DISMISSAL

This case came before the Court for consideration of the Plaintiff's Motion to Dismiss, filed in this matter on May 14, 2021. The prosecution and the defense mutually represent to the Court that they have entered into a plea agreement whereby the Defendant will enter a guilty plea to an amended charge of misdemeanor Falsification in the Municipal Court to resolve the charges presented in this Common Pleas Court for felony Illegal Voting and receive a mutually agreed upon sentence in that action. The Court finds and determines that the Plea Agreement between the parties constitutes good cause shown to dismiss this action at this time, reserving only the option that if the Defendant fails to plead guilty in the Municipal Court in connection with the charge presented in this case, the charge may be reinstated in the Common Pleas Court and the case may proceed as if there had been no Plea Agreement and Dismissal. Costs are assessed against the Defendant by agreement of the parties.
