**AFFIDAVIT OF PROBABLE CAUSE**

Your Affiants, Detective Shawn M. WILLIAMS and Detective James P. NOONE of the Luzerne County District Attorney's Office being duly sworn to law, depose and say:

On October 8, 2020, Luzerne County Director of Administrative Services David PARSNIK related he had potential information of voter fraud. He related the Luzerne County Board of Elections, 20 North Pennsylvania Boulevard, Wilkes-Barre, PA 18701 "flagged" a Pennsylvania Application for Absentee Ballot form by utilizing the **Statewide Uniform Registry of Electors** system. They received the application form on September 4, 2020 at 0947 hours. After referencing the **SURE** system, it was realized that the applicant is deceased.

The applicant is named Marie P. HANNIGAN, DOB: 05/28/31. The application listed HANNIGAN's address as: 134 Center Street, Forty Fort, PA 18704 and that she has lived at this address since 2015. Under Section A of the Application it listed her reason for absence as: "Visiting great grand kids... Oct. 24 – Nov. 10". There is a signature present under VOTER SIGNATURE HERE X "Marie HANNIGAN".

After a query of Marie P. HANNIGAN's voter information (ID 00543678-40) using the **SURE** system, the Department of Health made notification to the Bureau of Elections that HANNIGAN has been deceased since 2015. HANNIGAN's voter information was changed to deceased on August 21, 2015 as per the **SURE** system and the Luzerne County Board of Elections. HANNIGAN's voter information listed her as residing at 2 Crestview Drive, Dallas, PA 18612, DOB: 05/28/31. HANNIGAN is listed that she last voted on November 4, 2014. HANNIGAN's signature on file with the Luzerne County Board of Elections looks nothing like her purported signature on the recently received Pennsylvania Application for Absentee Ballot.

Detectives were provided with a listing of all registered voters residing at 134 Center Street, Forty Fort. They are: Robert R. LYNN, Loretta A. FRAWLEY-LYNN, Richard M. LYNN, Christopher R. LYNN, and Kerriann M. LYNN.

*QUERY OF INFORMATION*

On October 8, 2020, Detectives queried information for Marie P. HANNIGAN, specifically her JNET information through the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation. It was found that Marie P. HANNIGAN, DOB: 05/28/31, is listed with an address of 2 Crestview Drive, Dallas, PA 18612. The last time HANNIGAN's license was issued: March 23, 2015. The expiration date is listed as: May 29, 2019.

Detectives queried information for Robert R. LYNN, specifically his JNET information through the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation. I found Robert R. LYNN, DOB: 05/13/53, is listed with an address of 134 Center Street, Forty Fort, PA 18704.

Detectives queried Marie P. HANNIGAN, DOB: 05/28/31 through TransUnion TLOxp and requested a comprehensive report. The report listed her date of death as: May 9, 2015. Listed under the Address Summary for HANNIGAN were: 2 Crestview Drive, Dallas and 134 Center Street, Forty Fort. Robert R. Lynn is listed as a co-owner of 2 Crestview Drive, Dallas.

*INTERVIEW OF ROBERT RICHARD LYNN*

On October 8, 2020, Detective WILLIAMS and Detective NOONE travelled to the LYNN residence, 134 Center Street, Forty Fort, Luzerne County, Pennsylvania. As we were pulling up in our unmarked police vehicle, Robert Richard LYNN was exiting the front door of his residence and walking toward a driveway. Detectives exited our vehicle and stood on the sidewalk in front of the LYNN residence of 134 Center Street. We identified ourselves as Luzerne County Detectives. LYNN stood in his yard.

Detective WILLIAMS informed him that we are conducting an investigation and asked him if he is familiar with Marie HANNIGAN. He related that she is his mother. Detective WILLIAMS asked him, "Where is she?" LYNN turned toward the door and implied that she was inside his residence by responding, "Here." LYNN appeared very nervous with his response. Detective WILLIAMS told him that we have a Pennsylvania Application for Absentee Ballot; however, HANNIGAN is listed as deceased. LYNN immediately told Detectives that she died 5 years ago. LYNN agreed that she was deceased.

Detective WILLIAMS indicated there is a problem if she is deceased because someone recently sent the Pennsylvania Application for Absentee Ballot to Luzerne County purporting that she is alive. LYNN immediately began to tell Detectives about his mother's husband's (Herbert HANNIGAN) daughter that made dispute over Marie HANNIGAN's Last Will and Testament. He related that she has caused problems with their family and suspects that she may be the source of the false application.

As Detective WILLIAMS began to ask for her name, LYNN appeared more nervous. It was indicated that we would need to speak with her. He stressed that she is a problem amongst their family.


At this point, Detective WILLIAMS told LYNN that we believe he was lying to us and that he should not make this situation worse by blaming others. It was indicated that we are prepared to send the application to the United States Secret Service for analysis. Detective WILLIAMS asked LYNN, "Did you send in the application?" He said, "Yes." LYNN nodded his head in the affirmative. Detective WILLIAMS asked him if he signed his mother's name to the application and he responded, "Yes." After being asked, LYNN related he listed on the application that his mother wanted an absentee ballot because she was "visiting her grandkids or something like that." He added that he knew it was wrong to do what he did but he did it anyway.

Detective WILLIAMS asked him to explain the process of sending in the fictitious application and he agreed. LYNN related he retrieved a Pennsylvania Application for Absentee Ballot online and printed the form. Using his IBM typewriter, LYNN filled out the blocks of the application, purporting himself as his mother. Once he was done with the typing portion, LYNN signed the form using his mother's name and sent the application. LYNN related he did not trace his mother's name. LYNN was shown the Pennsylvania Application for Absentee Ballot listing his mother's name and information. LYNN identified the form as being the one that he filled out. He identified the signature of "Marie HANNIGAN" as being signed by him. Again, LYNN apologized for causing a problem but related he wanted to help Detectives so it would not become a larger problem.

Detective NOONE asked LYNN if he would voluntarily provide his typewriter or the typewriter ribbon that he used to complete the application. LYNN agreed to retrieve the typewriter ribbon to help us with our investigation. Detective NOONE asked LYNN if he understood that speaking with us was completely voluntarily and LYNN agreed that he has not been threatened or promised anything.

LYNN related he did this action alone and that no other family members were involved.
