Re: Right-to-Know Request

Dear Ms. Rumbaugh:

On June 6, 2012, the Attorney General's Office received an email from you in which you requested a list of all voter fraud cases prosecuted in the State of New Hampshire since 2000. Your request has been treated as a Right-to-Know Law request under RSA 91-A.

Based on what we have been able to find, this office has prosecuted two (2) cases of voter fraud since 2000. The information regarding these cases is as follows:

Case 1:

- Case #: 05-CR-04655
- Defendant's Name: Timothy Barnes
- City (County): Dover (Strafford)
- Election: 11/2/2004 (State General Election)
- Charges/Allegations: Providing a false address when registering to vote
- Statute Violated: RSA 659:34
- Resolution Date: 2/28/2006
- Disposition: Conviction - \$500 fine suspended for 2 years

Case 2:

- Case #: 212-2009-CR-00263
- Defendant's Name: Christopher Luke Fithian
- City (County): Jackson (Carroll)
- Election: 11/4/2008 (State General Election)
- Charges/Allegations: Voting twice for office of the President & applying for a ballot after already voting
- Statute Violated: RSA 659:34
- Resolution Date: 11/16/2010
- Disposition: Guilty plea - 12 month suspended prison sentence & 200 hours of community service

In addition to the above mentioned cases, this office is aware of a voter fraud case out of Londonderry, New Hampshire that was prosecuted by the Londonderry Police Department. The case apparently arose out of a seventeen (17) year old using a false name to vote during the Presidential Primary held on January 24, 2004.
