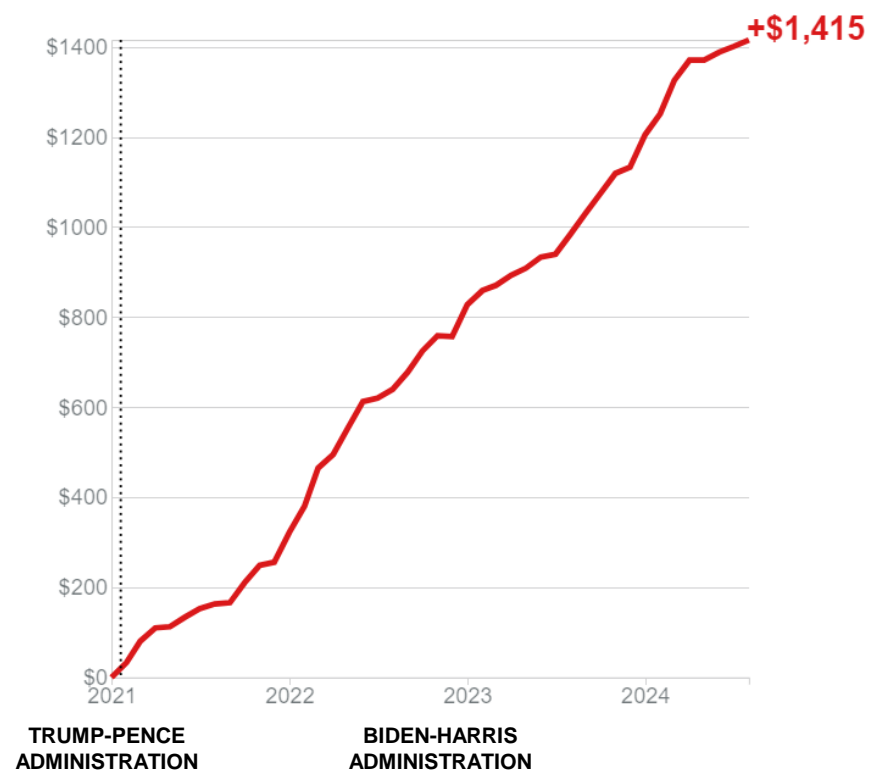

Change in My Monthly Expenses



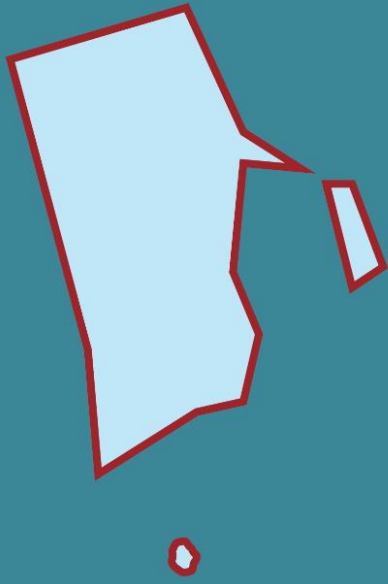

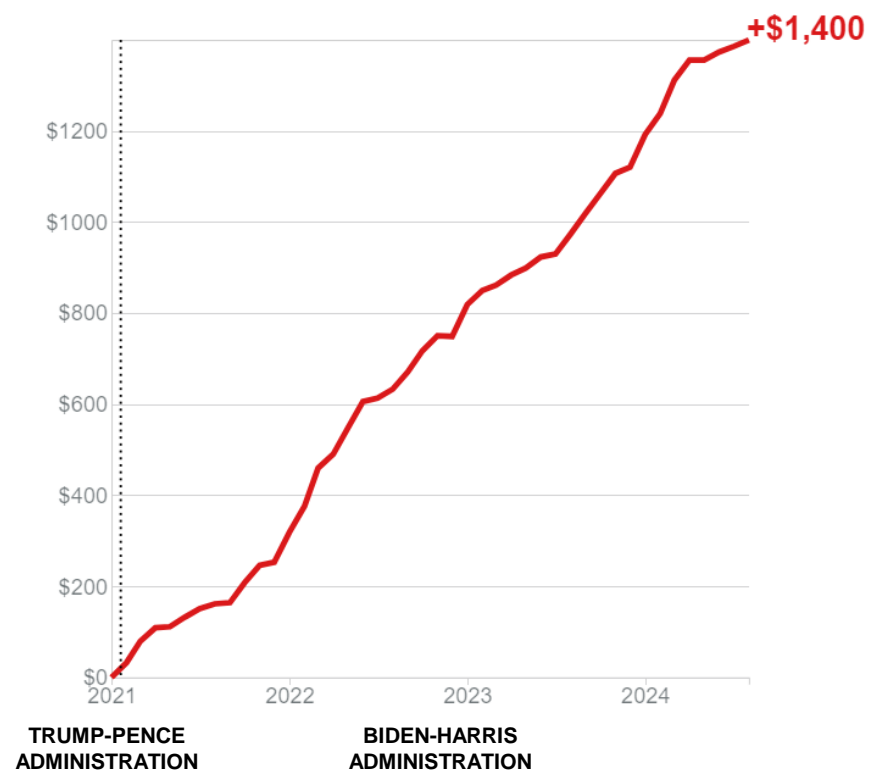

Change in My Monthly Expenses



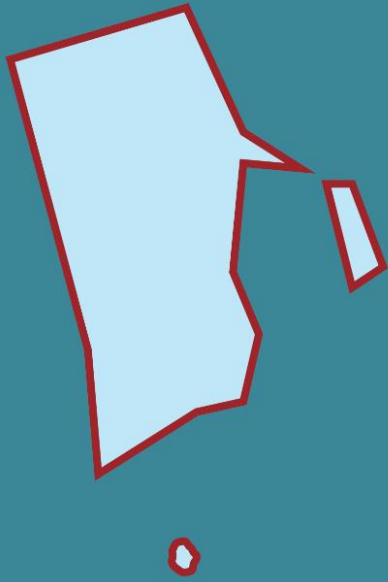

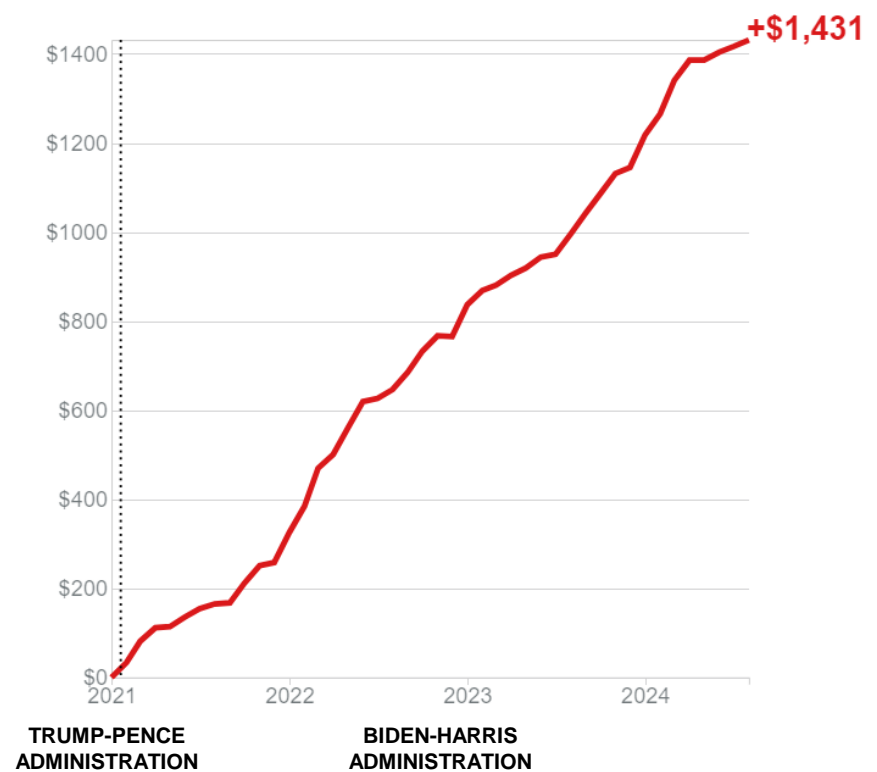
