Man was protecting others when he shot, killed another man outside North Omaha club, prosecutor says

The man who shot and killed a 37-year-old man outside a nightclub in North Omaha early Sunday will not be charged, Douglas County Attorney Don Kleine said Wednesday.

Kleine said the man was acting in self-defense and saving the lives of others when he shot and killed Brandon Jones around 3 a.m. near 24th and Binney Streets.

According to Kleine, Jones was asked by management to leave the club. Jones angrily left the club. He got a gun, went back to the club, brandished the gun and started firing it while making threats, Kleine said. Kleine added Jones' gunfire hit several people.

The man, whom Kleine declined to identify, returned fire, striking and ultimately killing Jones outside the club, which had a large crowd of people inside. Jones was pronounced dead at the Nebraska Medical Center. Blood stains could be seen as recently as Tuesday on the sidewalk in front of and near the club.
